### ***Minutes of last meeting, March 7, 2002:***

- ❖ Treasury report \$323.45
- ❖ First on the discussion was the past Deer Classic and the new CAA "Kids shooting tent."
  - It was decided it was a success!
  - 4-H made approx. \$525 from the use of it and their pellet gun shooting gallery. The two complimented each other nicely and 4H representative Greg Van Hove spoke about it's use and he graciously donated \$50 back to the club for use of the tent.
  - He also spoke of possible use by the 4-H at the Boone County Fair. It was felt by all CAA members at the meeting that this was terrific! This is what the tent was constructed for!
  - Possibly down the road, we may lend the tent out to other 4-H groups, but we felt the need to keep it local at this time. A few improvements could/will be made. Also, a box capable of containing all of it will be made.
  - Total cost, so far, is \$1027.30 which is a bit more than expected, but the safety net and the heavy-duty tarps to contain the arrows ran a bit more \$'s.
  - If you have not seen it yet, you will be pleased, especially if you use it on a club hunting trip since it can be converted to a very nice community gathering tent complete with room dividers.
  - A motion was made and seconded to charge outside groups such as 4-H \$75 per use for wear and tear/upkeep and if club members wish to use it, it will be free of charge.
  - A motion was also made to purchase the additional tarp from Kerwin which he had bought for the backside of the tent. Also, Charlie Davidson was paid for the safety net he had ordered. These bills were figured into the total cost mentioned earlier.
  - The tent will be kept at Jim Wiseman's home for now.

- ❖ The subject of past due members was brought up and I will be sending out reminders to all those people.
