Minutes of last meeting, October 3, 2002:

- ❖ Treasury report \$303.55
 - ❖ First on the agenda to discuss was the recent Heritage Festival at Nifong Park.
 - Our kids shooting tent was set up there and everyone enjoyed testing their skill at popping a balloon or sticking the turkey.
 - For the two day event we had a constant waiting line.
 - Members helping out with this were Jerry Griffen, Charlie Langreder, Jim Wiseman and myself Allen Bock.
 - We had been asked by Brian Flowers of the MDC to compliment the department's involvement at the Festival. In addition to being a sponsor of this Columbia Parks and Rec. event. MDC offered a laser shooting booth, fishing rod casting instruction and an "Identify and enjoy wildlife" information table. Our archery tent drew the most attention with many families patiently waiting for a 2nd, 3rd or 4th turn!
 - ❖ While on the subject of MDC we agreed we would contact Brian Flowers and set up a Bowhunter Education Instructor class to be held next Feb. or March.
 - ❖ At the time of the meeting, being the 3rd day of Archery season we talked about Share the Harvest. Club member Denny Ballard of the Conservation Federation is administering this wonderful program and in the absence of Charlie Langreder Secy Allen Bock outlined a few key points of this years program.
 - This Years goal is 100,000 lbs = 2000 deer.
 - Last year the total was 76,171 lbs with 1086 donors.
 - This year with a whole deer donation the Conservation Federation will payback \$25 to offset the processing cost which the donor will incur, a decal to show other citizens that you have participated. Also with a whole deer donated the hunter will be entered into a drawing at season end with prizes such as Bass Pro Shop donated Winchester 150X muzzleloader, a \$500 shopping spree plus and an additional 50 prizes. Shelter Insurance continues to be a major sponsor along with partial funding for the Mo. Dept of Conservation from tax on Non-resident hunters.
 - Let's do our best at helping Denny achieve his goal of 100,000 lbs. At this writing Charlie L and myself have donated whole deer.
 - ❖ Yes, we will have the "Mystery Deer" contest again this year with the prize being the winners choice of a \$50 gift certificate to Powder Horn Gunshop or one of Kelly Veach's deer carts he has made. Works slick! I have seen it in action.
 - Make sure you keep track of the date of each of your kills and get the info to me, Allen, either at the meeting, leaving me a message on my phone 449-7516 or email me at abock@tranquility.net.
 - At the Feb. meeting (Wildgame Supper Nite) we will draw the date of the archery season from a hat till we hit a kill date. In the event of 2 members on the same date (such as Allen and Brent on Oct 16th) we will either flip a coin or draw straws to pick the winner. Good Luck!
