

Minutes of Oct 7th CAA meeting

Discussion of next month's meeting Nov 4th program. Taxidermist Kenny Jurgensmeyer of North Central Mo Archery Club in Moberly will talk and demonstrate field care and taxidermy process. Jim Wiseman spoke of the City's Hunting Program. Jim George of the MDC had told him that as of Oct 6th 3 deer had been reported, possibly 7 total harvested. The only issues that have come up have been hunters concerns that not all hunters are parking in the proper designated area at the landfill site.

In addition, a motion was passed to include all states fall deer and turkey harvest to be eligible for the Mystery Deer Contest. Contest will conclude at the end of the Missouri Archery Deer Season, which is January 15th 2005. This ruling will grant Kerwin's fine 6x6 Mule Deer a entry into the Mystery Deer hat which will be drawn at the Feb Wild Game Supper.
