The following topics were discussed:

- *American Legion bow range: The date to fix/repair the target butts will be Wed. April 2 at 5:30.
- *We are also adding a 3rd bulletin board for club use at the Powder Horn
- *Fish Contest rule change was made for the upcoming bowfishing contest. It was decided that next year people can put an entry in the contest for each specie of rough fish.
- *April -bowfish/turkey hunt @ Tablerock Lake at Hunters Friend Resort at Indian Point. It looks like several people are going but Joe Pendergrass will check with the resort owner about options/details. We'll keep you updated for those interested. I believe it will be the first weekend of Turkey Season.
- *Joe also filled us in on their pig hunt in Oklahoma. 7 of the 9 hunters killed pigs using pistols. 2 day hunt costing about 350.00 ea. (pigs saw every day on 2-3 thousand acres. It was roughly an 8 hour drive. It may be a place for a future group hunt. I believe he said the place only recently opened for hunting.
- *An Antelope hunt is in the works if any interest. Rick has been unable to reach the landowner but she is supposed to call him back. Previous hunts had a 300 trespass fee. Drawing applications for the first drawing in Cheyanne, Wy. by March 15th at 5. We won't make that but, we will look at the 2nd drawing in July if we can locate a spot to hunt. Antelope doe tags are \$340TC for nonresidents. We figure a Wyoming Antelope hunt would roughly cost about the same as a public ground self Elk hunt.
- *We are planning a club bow fishing trip on the Lamine river for silver carp as soon as we have a good report on conditions. Get your bows and boats ready.
- *Patches-micro weave vs. embroidered were looked at. With one minor change in the micro weave and they would be ready at about 3 bucks a patch. They would look real nice on a ball cap.
- *We were brainstorming on coming up with fundraising ideas. If anyone has an Idea feel free to bring it up.
